



**Michael Schwager** is Professor of Art History and Museum Studies at Sonoma State University, where he also directs the University Art Gallery. Michael joined the faculty at Sonoma in 1991 after more than a decade working in several California art museums, including the San Diego Museum of Contemporary Art, the Berkeley Art Museum, the Richmond Art Center, and the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art. Since 1985, Michael has curated, lectured on, and written about Modern and Contemporary Art with a focus on the work of Northern California artists. From 2003 to 2009 (concurrent with his position at Sonoma State), he served as Curator at the di Rosa Museum in Napa, where he managed the extensive collection of Bay Area art and organized many exhibitions.
